Dear Friends,

In August of this year Ival Secrest stepped down as the President of Friends of Ostomates Worldwide-USA. As you may know Ival was on the Board of Directors of FOW-USA for 15 years. The organization owes a great depth of gratitude to Ival for the outstanding leadership he has brought to the Board as the organization has continued on our mission. In our last newsletter Ival outlined several of the areas that have been developed and improved, but what was not in his last president's message and that the Board of Directors knows is that Ival worked tirelessly on a daily basis to organize the workings of the FOW-USA. He is an unselfish man, a great communicator, a kind person and kept the Board focused on the work of the organization. Thank you Ival for all you have done. We are happy to know that he will remain on the Board as the past president, and already he has worked to help me with an orientation to the Board's business as well as has taken on several new projects.

We have several projects on our agenda for the upcoming year. At our last Board meeting held in August, 2011 we discussed ways that we could enhance the FOW-USA's presence. Here are a two of the issues we discussed:

1. We have noted that Spanish ostomy literature has been accessed consistently on our website and we have received several inquiries in the Spanish language. We have no Board members who are fluent in Spanish.
2. Since the organization is web based, that is we reach out to the global community via our website, we need to be sure that it is up to date and communicating our mission. We also feel that we should look at additional social media to get our mission communicated to the broadest base possible.

We are looking for a few good people who might be able to help us with the two issues above. We need to recruit a volunteer to help translate Spanish incoming requests for products. While it is hard to determine the volume of these requests, it now ranges from 1-2 a month. If this volunteer activity is something that you could participate in, let me know. The work would be online via email and would be a valuable contribution to our organization. The work of website updating and initiating a social media page is another volunteer opportunity for a person or persons with those skills. Again this would be web based and would need to be handled by someone comfortable with that media. As a nurse who has specialized in the care of persons with ostomies for almost my entire career, I understand the importance of having the correct product to manage a stoma. The mission of the FOW-USA: "to provide ostomy supplies and educational materials to help ostomates in need around the world" is one that I know is critically important and I am looking forward to my work as the President of FOW-USA.
