What is FOW-USA? FOW-USA is a volunteer run, non-profit founded in 1985


Our primary mission is to:

Why is FOW-USA needed?

- Ostomates in developing countries may not be able to get affordable supplies, and may have to manage their ostomy using:
 - plastic bags
 - metal cans
 - rubber gloves or
 - rags or towels

- The quality of life is poor.
- Skin care is a major issue
 - Ostomates may be rejected by their families, friends and people in their communities.





Why is FOW-USA needed?

A Nigerian man said "You won't imagine how I have been managing myself ... It is really shameful and disgraceful. I pray for your help." We sent supplies to Dr. Brian Camazine, a US surgeon who works in Nigeria.

Requirements of recipients



 Recipients must have the ability to receive the materials and distribute them free of charge to needy ostomates.





We coordinate efforts with the Friends of Ostomates Worldwide Canada, as well as the International Ostomy Association and its regional organizations as well as others.



FOW-USA

Provides funds annually to the Lions for Stoma Care Project to support the stoma care education of doctors and nurses in developing countries.













Collecting supplies

Supplies are sent to a central warehouse in Louisville, Kentucky, USA.

Sources for supplies include:

- people with surplus supplies no longer needed;
- facilities that can no longer use supplies or are changing to other brands;
- ostomy support groups that may have supplies donated by members.
- Donors send supplies at their own expense and receive an acknowledgement for tax purposes.









Products ready for repacking



- At the warehouse, volunteers sort the supplies, putting the same sizes and brands together.
- Used supplies are not accepted





What supplies are acceptable?

- Pouches
- Flanges
- Skin barriers
- Skin wipes
- Paste
- Tape
- Belts
- Pouch covers
- Scissors
- Pediatric products





Sending supplies worldwide - process

- Requests for supplies are received through the internet and other sources and from previous clients.
- A volunteer communicates with trusted individuals and organizations in the receiving country, such as
 - hospitals,
 - clinics,
 - doctors,
 - ostomy nurses,
 - and ostomy associations.
- Product needs are identified.



April 2023

 Plans are made to ensure that the supplies will be distributed free of charge to needy ostomates.



Sending supplies worldwide

- Potential clients answer questions about:
 - The specific supplies needed
 - How we should ship supplies, including regulatory documents, such as consulate stamps
 - How instruction will be provided to the ostomates.

The funding covers expenses, such as shipping costs, and the rental of warehouse space.



- Include in supply shipment
 Your name and address on the return label as well as in the shipping box.
- Use the UPS Flat Rate Shipping Program
- All contributors will receive an acknowledgement letter.
- We are a registered 501(c)(3) corporation with the Internal Revenue Service. This means that your financial and supply donations and cost of postage may be taxdeductible on your Federal income tax.



- 1. Go to WWW.FOWUSA.ORG
- 2. Select DONATE > Donate Supplies (from the menu)
- 3. Click UPS FLAT RATE SHIPPING LABEL
- 4. Donate \$15.00 for each shipping box
- 5. Click "continue as guest"
- 6. Enter your "ship from" information
- Enter the weight for each carton. Determining accurate weight is critical **
- 8. Click "Process Shipment" button
- 9. Print and attach the UPS label(s) to the carton(s)
- 10. Drop-off carton(s) at an authorized UPS location

An email confirmation is sent upon receiving carton(s).

Frequently Asked Questions

When do the UPS labels print? After completing your donation, entering your name, address, and the weight of the box, then selecting "Submit" generates the labels. Use your printer to create the UPS label.

USA

Do I have to re-pack everything?

Your choice. You can put everything you have into the shipping carton. OR put like product into a plastic bag (squeeze out the air + write quantity on the bag) and put into carton. This increases the capacity of the carton and requires fewer cartons to be shipped.

Can I donate without having a PayPal

account? YES - select Donate with Debit or Credit Card. The email confirmation for your donation comes from PayPal. Check the SPAM or JUNK folder if confirmation isn't in your inbox.

I need help with the UPS link and/or printing the UPS labels? Send an email to <u>flatrateshipping@fowusa.org</u> for help.

How do I accurately weigh a carton? Put carton on scale or hold carton, get on scale then deduct body weight. Do not just enter 40 pounds.

What box can be used for shipping?

Use a clean LARGE carton up to 20 inches in any dimension (length, width or height). Cross off any stray marks from prior use with a black marker or pen.

What's your shipping address? FOW-USA 4018 Bishop Lane, Louisville, KY 40218. This address prints automatically on the UPS labels when using the Flat Rate Shipping program.

> How do I enter more than one box? Click the ADD button after entering the weight of the first box.
